Brief Historic Fort Wayne History:

1000CE Native American burial site; 1710-1771 Potawatami Village site; July 1812 location of the bombardment of Sandwich, Canada; Aug 1812 site of British General Brock's Army invasion of U.S.; Sept 1815 location of the signing of the Treaty of Springwells; 1842 start of Fort Wayne construction; 1861 site becomes Michigan's principle Civil War training camp; 1940 Fort Wayne becomes the hub of the Arsenal of Democracy.
